


SUSTAINABILITY AT STOCKHOLMSMÄSSAN

FOOD & BEVERAGE
All restaurants in our venue are certified with the Swedish sustainability label KRAV, which means that whatever you crave, our menus will cater to your tastebuds as well as the planet. We do not serve any fish or seafood that is red-listed by WWF and we convert all food waste into climate friendly biogas.



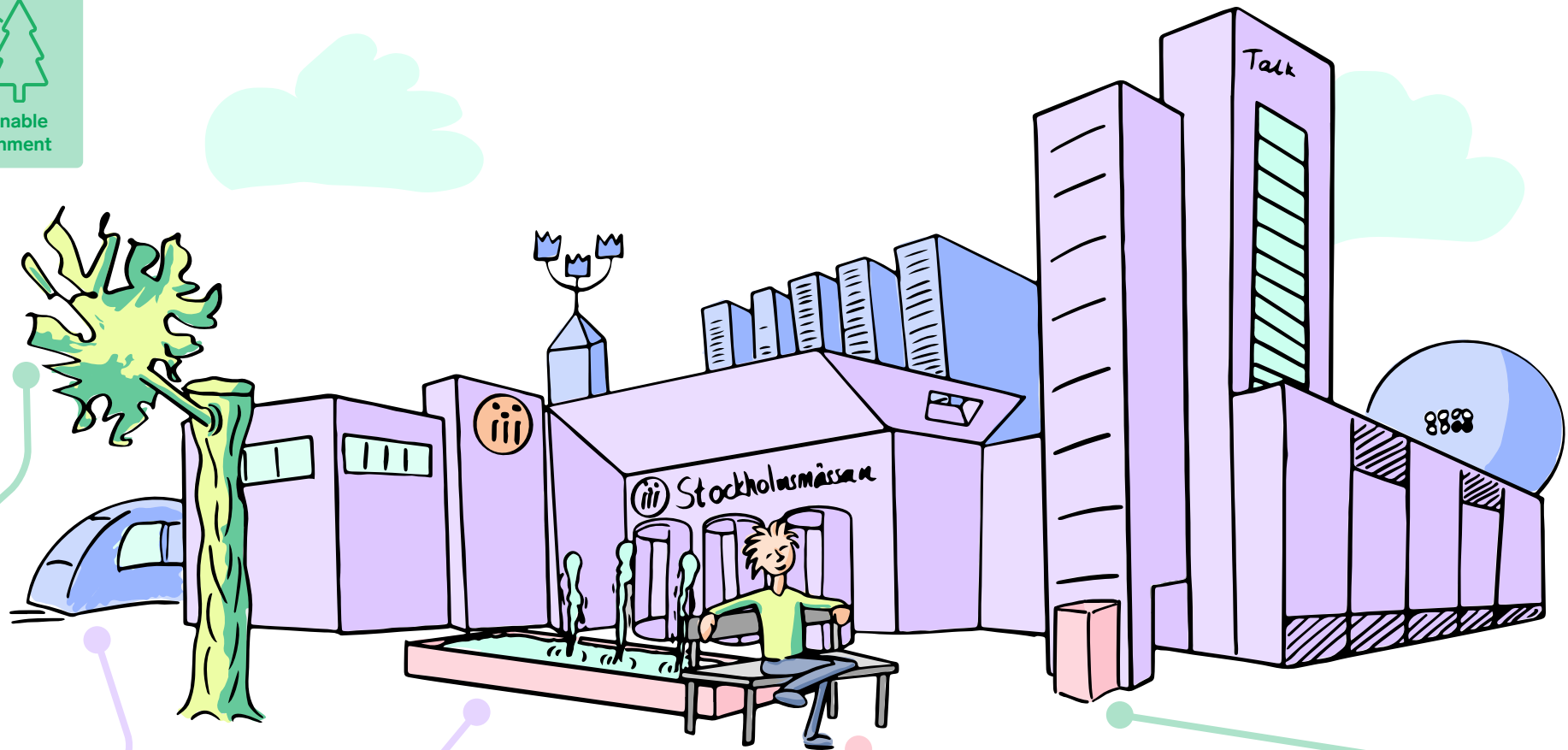
ENERGY & VENTILATION
Our power consumption is constantly decreasing. Efficient heat pumps regulate temperatures, and the exhibition halls are easily partitioned so no areas are heated or ventilated while unused. Also, the electricity we use is ecolabelled and derived from renewable sources. Reducing our carbon footprint really gives us energy.




CERTIFICATIONS
In 2019 we proudly obtained a certification for ISO 20121 – Sustainable Event Management. Our suppliers (such as the cleaning company and the hotel next door) all hold several sustainability certifications and ecolabels as well.



BIODIVERSITY
Biodiversity is a requirement for all life. We further biodiversity by maintaining our own park where the lawn gets to grow wildly and attract pollinating insects such as bees, bumblebees, and butterflies, which are vital to all our food crops and eco systems. Let it bees!




TRANSPORTS

And speaking of energy, as much as possible of our internal logistics fleet consists of electric vehicles. For everything else we use 100% environmental fuels.

Water is not only the best quencher of thirst there is and utterly essential to our existence. It is also a human right. We use low-flow faucets and toilets to spend less water. Every little drop helps.



SAFETY & WELLBEING

We take a safe work environment for granted and our employees can enjoy several benefits such as a collective agreement, wellness allowance, an hour per week for exercising and the possibility of joining work-related art, sports or sustainability club.
